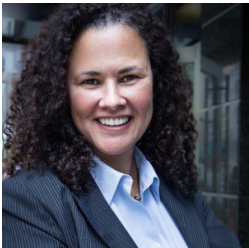

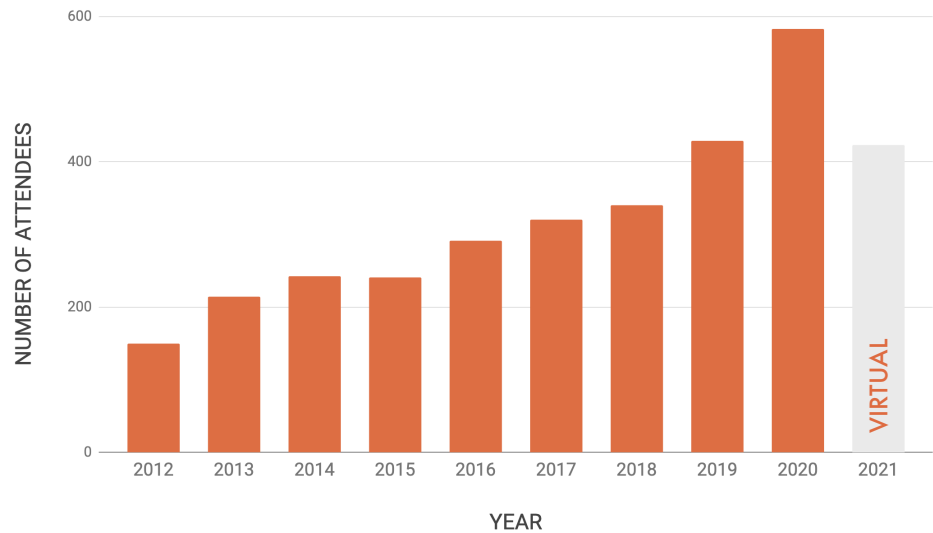

NUMBER OF ATTENDEES BY YEAR



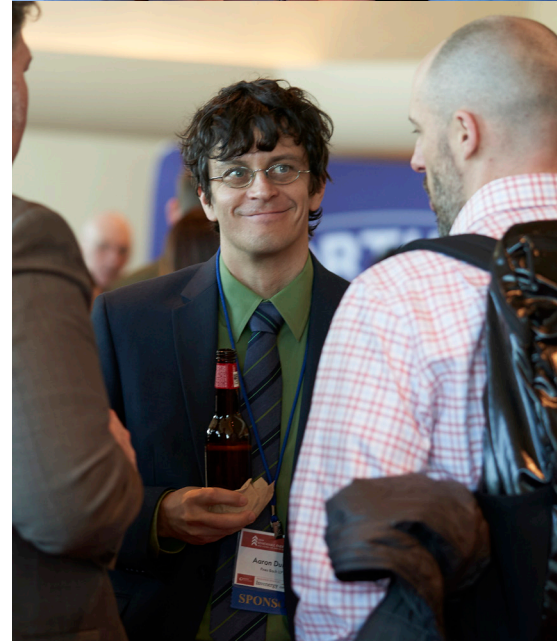

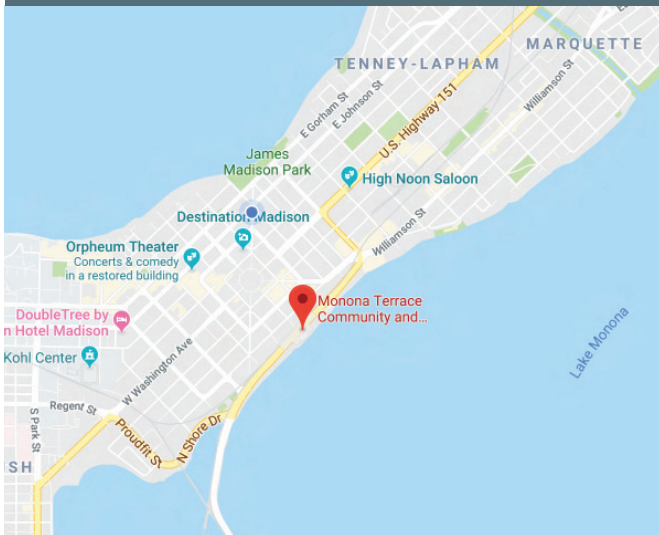
PREMIER LOCATION

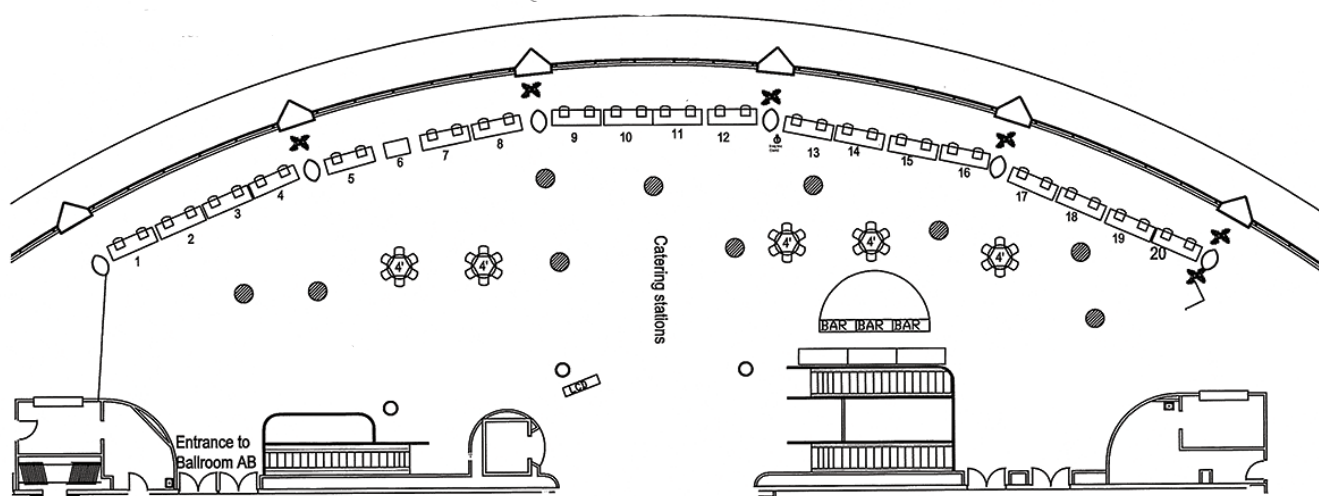

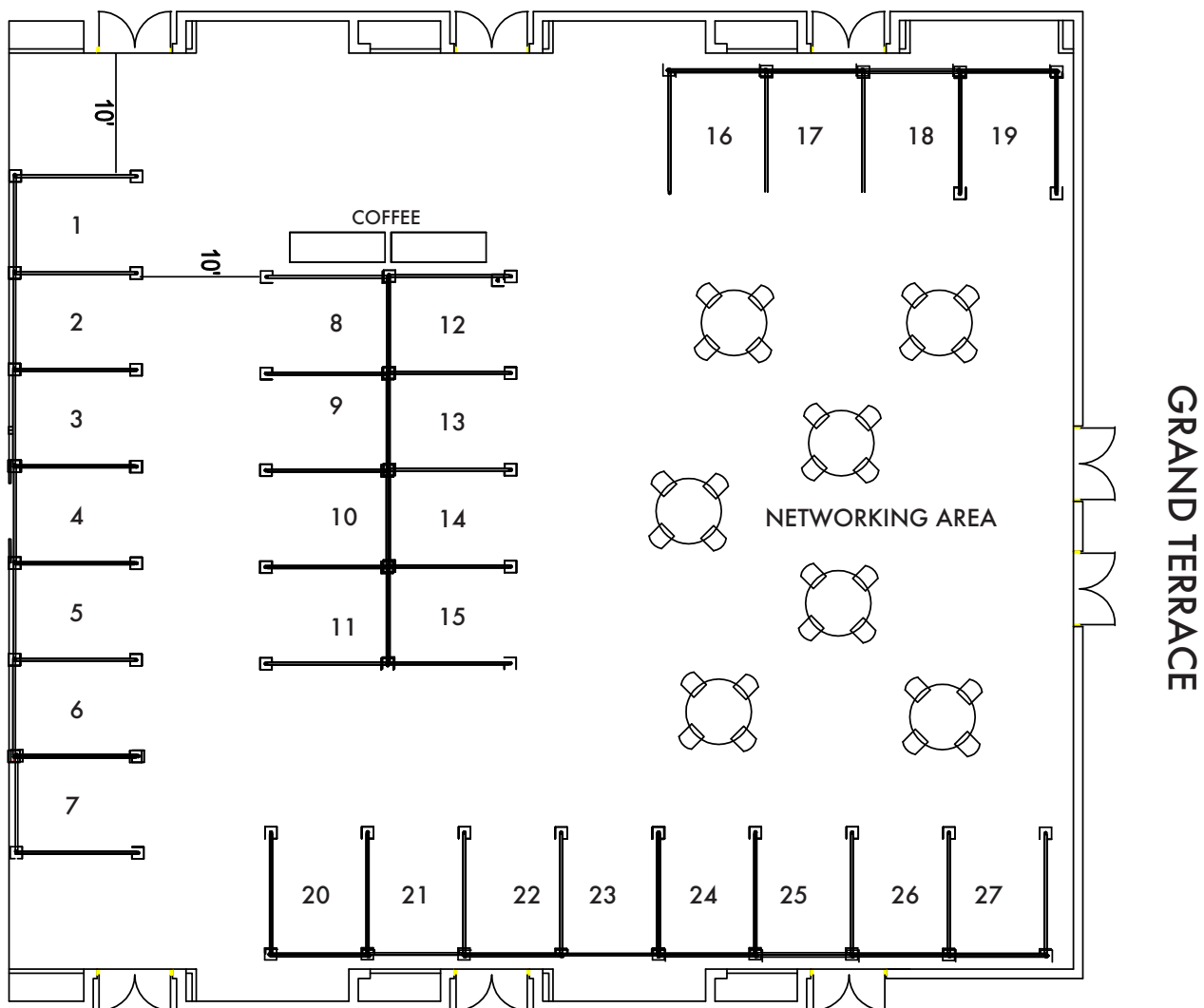
